**Fundraising and Grant Applications within**

Area Meeting, Local Meetings or any other group within the AM wishing to do any fund-raising or grant applications should read the Charities Commission document:

One of the implications of the advice in that document is that the Area Meeting Trustees have legal responsibility for any type of fund-raising outside of the AM carried out within the AM, and so AM Trustees should be advised of any fund-raising to be undertaken by the Area Meeting, any of the Local Meetings in the AM or any other subsidiary body within the AM.

If the fund-raising includes applying for grants from any body external to the AM, then the grant application should be made in the name of the Trustees. The AM, LM or other group can make enquiries, and complete the application forms, but the application should be sent and signed by Trustees.

For other fund-raising outside of the AM, Trustees should be advised before the actual fund-raising starts and should be kept informed of progress.
